



Initiatives to develop research culture at VIM

VIM has identified a few priority areas of research. The faculty & students are encouraged to undertake the research in the following broad areas, and any other areas of interest and benefit to VIM:

1. Management of Innovation & Technology
2. Entrepreneurship Development
3. International Trade
4. Corporate Governance & Corporate Social Responsibility
5. Oriental Management Practices

Any interdisciplinary research is always promoted.

VIM has initiated some steps to encourage the research activities in VIM & create a vibrant research culture.

1. A junior faculty member undertaking a research project will be assigned a grant of Rs. 10,000 if he/she completes the projects within the stipulated time frame.
2. A total amount of Rs. 1,00,000 will be given in the form various grants for encouraging participation of the faculty members in research activities.
3. Besides this, faculty members can work with a group of 2 to 3 students on a research project. Such students will be assigned a grant of Rs. 2,000. A total amount of Rs. 30,000 will be given away as grants to the students who are engaged in various research based activities.
