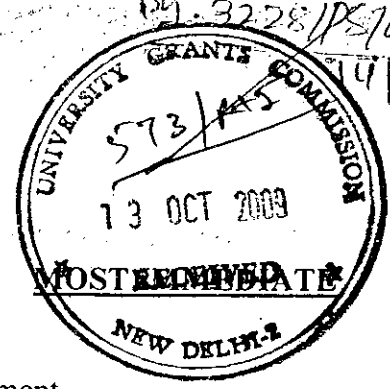

Subject:- Enhancement in the age of superannuation from 62 to 65 years for teaching positions in educational institutions in higher and technical education.

Sir,

I am directed to say that orders were issued by this Ministry enhancing the age of superannuation of persons holding teaching positions in centrally funded institutions in higher and technical education under the purview of this Ministry, from 62 to 65 years vide this Ministry's letter No. 1-19/2006-U.II dated 23.03.2007. ( copy at Annexure-I ). It was also clarified vide Ministry's letter dated 19.4.2007 ( copy at Annexure-II ) that the provisions of the Ministry's letter dated 23.3.2007 mentioned above shall **not** be applicable to any other categories of employees in such institutions, notwithstanding the fact that the posts they hold may be considered as 'equivalent' to teaching positions

2. The question of extending the enhanced age of superannuation to teachers in higher educational institutions in Andaman and Nicobar Island and Daman has been under consideration. On a reference from the Ministry of Home Affairs, recommending enhancement of the age of superannuation of college teachers in the UTs of A&N Islands and Daman from 62 to 65 years, this Ministry had conveyed it's no objection to the Ministry of Home Affairs to the proposal.

3. In para 2 of its Order dated 17.4.2009 in OA No. 73/AN/07 and No. 23/AN/2009, the Hon'ble Central Administrative Tribunal, Calcutta Bench (Circuit Bench at Port Blair) had directed as under:-

"This matter has been under adjudication in view of the withdrawal of implementation of enhancement of age from 62 to 65 years at the instance of the M/o HRD. The Ministry of HRD has now expressed no objection. It would appear that the Ministry of Home Affairs has to complete the formality by issue of necessary orders. The Ministry of Home Affairs may need some time to issue necessary formal order in this regard. Let the Ministry of Home Affairs i.e. respondent No. 2 in OA



23/AN/2009, issue appropriate orders within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. Upon receipt of such orders, the UT Administration of A&N shall take appropriate steps to implement the same within a period of one month from the date of receipt."

4. The Ministry of Home Affairs has advised that since the concerned subject matter Union Ministries have been dealing with matters not within the delegated powers of UTs and since the Ministry of Human Resource Development is the subject matter Ministry in respect of education, orders increasing the age of superannuation of college teachers in the A&N Islands and Daman should be issued by the Ministry of Human Resource Development. Accordingly, it has been decided to extend the provisions contained in this Ministry's letter No. 1-19/2006-U.II dated 23.03.2007 and 19.04.2007 to all such teachers in higher and technical educational institutions under the UT Administrations of A&N Islands and Daman. & Diu.

5. It is requested that necessary steps may kindly be taken to implement the above decision.
